

Dear Sirs,

The ECB President Draghi wants to defend his policy in front of the German Bundestag.

The matter in question is the purchase of junk government bonds by the ECB and unrecoverable, unsecured claims of the Bundesbank in the amount of over € 700 billion (so-called target claims).

This policy violates the German Constitution, because Germany will in this way be liable for the debts of other countries. Germany will be dragged down ever deeper into the spiral of debt.

We have therefore submitted a [constitutional complaint](#) and called on the Federal Government to lodge a complaint with the ECJ against the ECB. We also call on you as members of the German parliament to stand up for German interests.

Our constitutional complaint is attached. We ask you to question Draghi's speech critically as an attempted defence. You should instead defend the independence of the German Bundestag and its budget sovereignty against the interference of the ECB in German sovereign rights.
